

Colebrook Roads – Chapin Road

June 23, 1795 David Johnson leased to Robert Stillman “sufficient quantity of land for a road to pass and re-pass with teams and carts or otherwise as the said Stillman may find necessary and to no other purpose, crossing my said lot, which I now live on. Beginning at the southwest corner of the field or cleared land on the farm which the said Stillman now lives on at the **South Road** and running southerly across my lot of land. Etc. **Land Records, vol.2, p.491**

Nov. 3, 1868 The selectmen discontinued what is now Chapin Road. **Town Meetings, vol. 2, p. 139**

Oct. 17, 1870 The town voted that the selectmen be requested to examine certain roads on Beech Hill and discontinue such roads in that vicinity as they deem advisable. **Town Meetings, vol. 2, p.**
