Colebrook School Accompt Book For the Colebrook School Society, 1800 Also Records of the Doings of the Committee Of Inspectors of Schools

This 7in. x 8in. book was part of the cache of documents discovered hidden in a closet in the office of the old town hall in 2001.

Records of the Doings of the Committee of Inspectors of Schools

At a meeting of the Committee of School inspectors holden at the house [of] Mr. Reuben Rockwell November 16th 1800 – Samuel Mills was chosen Moderator & Reuben Rockwell Clerk – Voted that this meeting be adjourned to Monday the 8th of December next to be holden at this place.

At a meeting of the Inspecting Committee of the School Society of Colebrook holden by adjournment at the house of Reuben Rockwell December 8th 1800 the Regulations for the schools marked No.3 were adopted and signed by the Committee –

The Committee then proceeded to the examination of Missrs. Moses & Wells, two persons conditionally employed as teachers in sd. Society in the same order as the several qualifications of a teacher are placed in the Regulations No.3rd.

After duly attending to their Learning Morals, the question was put by the Moderator as follows: Shall the two persons now examined be severally approved as teachers of schools in this Society? Voted in the affirmation. After making arrangements for Visiting the Schools the meeting was dissolved.

The teachers employed in this Society for the Winter ensuing are Jabez Wright in the North District; Asaph Pinney, South West District; Daniel Brainard, South District; Wells, Beech Hill; Henry Bliss, River District & Morss, [Morse ?] Forge District; all of whom except Morss & Wells have heretofore been examined & approved by the Inspectors of Schools in this Society.

December 7th 1801

At a meeting of the Overseers of Schools holden at the Dwelling House of Mr. Reuben Rockwell. Present, Samuel Mills, Nathan Bass, Moses Wright, Jr., Frederick Brown, Reuben Rockwell, Asa Bishop, overseers of schools for the year 1801 and until Oct 15 1802.

Samuel A, Mills Esq. was chosen Moderator & Reuben Rockwell, Clerk.

The Overseers then Proceeded to the examination of Uriel Smith, Seth Haydon, Timothy Babcock, Moses Haydon & Earl P. Hawley. After duly attending separately to their examination, the question was then put by the Moderator on each teacher separately and each was respectfully approved.

The Regulations of last year marked No.3 were again adopted without alteration or amendment. The teachers for the Present Winter in the Respective Districts are: Uriel Smith, North District; Moses Haydon, South District; Asaph Pinney, South West District; Timothy Babcock, Beech Hill District; Earl P. Hawley, River District; Seth Haydon, Forge District.

December 8th 1802

At a meeting of the Overseers of the Schools in the School Society in Colebrook holden at the dwelling house of Mr. Reuben Rockwell.....

Present, Rev. Chauncey Lee, Samuel Blakeley, Ammi R. Robbins, Francis Benedict, Asaph Pinney & Elijah Rockwell, Jr., Inspectors of Schools for the year 1802 & until October 1 1803.

Maj. Samuel Blakeley was chosen Moderator & Elijah Rockwell, Jr. Clerk.

The meeting first proceeded to form a constitution to guide them in the performance of their trust, and voted to adopt the one made by the Overseers of last year after revising & making several alterations, which may be seen in full on file and marked No.4. The Inspectors then proceeded to examine, identify and severally Mr. Uriel Smith, teacher in the North & Mr. Timothy Babcock in the Beech Hill District, and after duly attended to the same, on the question being put by the Moderators they were unanimously approved.

Voted, that this meeting be adjourned to the house of Rev. Chauncey Lee on Wednesday the 5th day of January 1803 at 6 o'clock afternoon, for the purpose of examining the several teachers who are to be employed the present winter in the respective districts who have not presented themselves at this meeting, and to transact such other business as may then be found proper.
